What Do We Do With Our Time?



Last month I watched a great video during Sunday school about 'time'. We cannot make up for lost time so let's evaluate our goals and work towards them using our time wisely. I wanted to share some of the ideas of this video with you; transferring them to the sport field. So let's use improving our serve as our goal. There are few statements to consider:

-There is a cumulative value in spending small amounts of time over a long period of time. 30 minutes three times a week will help us get to our goal.

-Neglect has a cumulative effect as well. So if we do not work on our serve we will not get to our goal.

-There are rarely immediate consequences for neglecting one installment over a long period of time. If we work on our serve twice a week instead of three times a week will not be noticed right away but it will take us longer to get to our goal.

-There is no cumulative value to the urgent things we do instead of doing the things that are important. I am supposed to work on my serve today but I need to check my email, watch TV, stay longer in bed, etc...these are urgent things that are not helping us to reach our goal.

-In the critical arena of life you cannot make up for lost time. We cannot obtain our goals by cramming. Doing 5,000 serves once a month will most likely injure us.

If we want to transfer this idea to all things in life, then let's set a goal spiritually, physically, relationally and professionally and work on it on a regular basis. A spiritual goal can be reading the bible, a physical goal can be getting fit and a relational goal could be spending more time with our spouses.

Remember, urgent things will not help us accomplish our goals. Let's be wise with our time by getting the maximum value out of it. The urgency of life will steal our time.

So if we ask ourselves why is he/she better in tennis than me? It is because he/she redeems the time. So what is robbing us from the daily investments needed to have a better serve, getting more fit, and/or spending more time with our family? Where do we need to make daily increments so there is value down the road? The urgent things may not be wrong, but they are not allowing us to reach our goals. It is not wrong to watch TV, to see one more client at work or to sleep longer, but if these things are taking time from our goals, then it is not the wise thing to do with our time. So let's evaluate our dreams and goals and let's use our time wisely.
