We wish everyone a summer filled with fun in the sun. Safety is of paramount importance to us at TOCC. All of our lifeguards are Red Cross Cross certified and trained to insure your safety.



Pool Facts

- Lifeguards on duty hours: Mon-Sat 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. and Sun 12:00 to 6:00 p.m.
- Members and guests must sign in.
- Minors under the age of 10 and non-swimmers must be accompanied by an adult at all time.
- Minors under the age of 15 are not allowed to use the pool after regular lifeguard hours unless accompanied poolside by an adult (18 years or older).

Thunder & lightning - According to the American Red Cross and the National Lightning Safety Institute: In the event of thunder or lightning lifeguards should clear the pool, waiting 30 minutes after the last observed sound of thunder or sight of lightning before letting swimmers reenter.
