It's League Time!

TOCC will be hosting 23 teams at the club this spring. The first few weeks of each season are always busy. Because of the extreme activity, it is a necessity that ALL members abide by the court rules:

1. Sign in for courts on the board by writing your name and start time.
2. Sign in all guests.
3. If courts are full, place your name on the waiting list.
4. When courts are full, players are limited to 1 1/2 hour play time. **NO ONE** is excluded!
5. Team matches and special events get priority over open play.
6. Courts 6 and 7 are reserved as lesson courts. They are available for open play when not in use by the Club professionals.

"The Code"

Did you know that the USTA League Rule 1.12 requires that all participants agree to play by the rules of tennis and the standards of good conduct, fair play, and good sportsmanship?

1.12 PLAYER AGREEMENT.

All players participating in the USTA League Tennis Program, as a condition of their participation, agree to abide and be bound by the USTA Constitution and By-Laws; the USTA Regulations; the Rules of Tennis (unless modified by these USTA LEAGUE TENNIS REGULATIONS); the USTA LEAGUE TENNIS REGULATIONS and the standards of good conduct, fair play and good sportsmanship.

The rules of tennis are written for umpired matches, and "The Code" is what guides us in applying those rules in non-umpired matches, to keep it fair. "The Code" includes not only how the rules should be applied (such as making calls on balls hit toward you), but also those rules of etiquette that make the game more enjoyable (such as what to do when partners don't agree on a call). Want to know more? The MTA has provided a copy of "The Code" to every team captain in a special effort to acquaint every league player with the rules.
