A Letter to TOCC Members

On Thursday, October 23, 2003 the Board of Directors of Treasure Oak Country Club voted to raise the monthly club dues by \$10 per month effective December 1, 2003. This will be an across the board increase for all members except for the Golden Membership category, which will see a \$5 per month increase, or half that of regular and associate members.

The board also voted to increase the current total membership by twenty five (25) from 275 active to 300 active members, pending the approval of the general membership. A self addressed and stamped ballot will be enclosed with the December invoice for you to cast your vote regarding this issue.

The board has made these decisions after many months of discussion regarding the future direction of the club and the wishes of the members. The fact that our property taxes for the club have doubled this year, coupled with the loss of our insurance carrier and an unexpected increase in property and liability insurance, also plays a large part in our action.

Be assured, this board is committed to preserving and maintaining all of the things that make TOCC a very special organization. We are working diligently to remain good stewards of the club's finances while pursuing our short term and long range goals for improving our facilities and your membership experience.

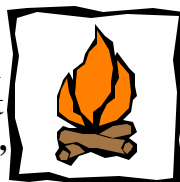
Ladies' 3.0 Super Seniors WIN State Championships

Pack your Tent for the TOCC Parent / Child Campout

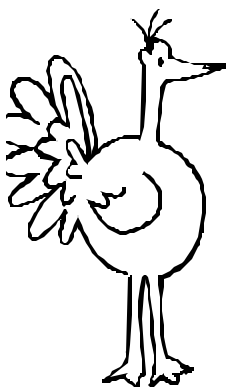
Let's go camping! TOCC will host an overnight family campout on the club grounds on **Friday, Nov. 14** starting at 6:00 p.m.

Tennis Committee addresses Court Availability during League Season



While TOCC boasts the most active and successful USTA league program on the coast, our league participation levels may present some challenges in the future without thoughtful planning. Your board of directors appointed a special committee to research our current court demand and to recommend the best approach for the future.

We traditionally offer a total of 24 time slots for league play in the spring. Last spring, there were 29 TOCC teams vying for those slots, and many of you experienced the frustration of trying to find an open practice court or time for a make up match during league season.

With many players enrolled on as many as four teams and entire teams "playing up," we may soon find ourselves with the dilemma of "too much of a good thing." *TOCC currently has more league teams than any other club in the area,* creating more demand for team court availability than we can supply during league season.

In order to insure our continued success and to provide the best service to our entire membership, we request that players limit their league play to the number of teams on which they can realistically participate. Additionally, we suggest that players desiring to "play up" do so with an adequate number of higher level players on their team so as to be reasonably competitive.

In order to accommodate both league and non-league players, only one 6:00 p.m. league match per week night will be allowed unless extreme circumstances exist. An additional league match at 8:00 p.m. will be allowed, and we can schedule 2.5 and senior level matches at 8:00 pm as well since they only require three courts.

To summarize, time slots for Spring League play will be as follows:

One league match per time slot*

Sundays: 2:00, 4:00, 6:00, 8:00 p.m.
 Mondays: 8:00 p.m. only
 Tuesday – Thursday: 6:00 & 8:00 p.m.
 Friday: 7:00 p.m.

* *Additional Senior and 2.5 level league matches requiring 3 courts will be allowed on all Sunday time slots and weekdays at 8:00 p.m.*

Our club has never had to limit league participation, and with everyone's help no further changes will be needed. Thanks for your enthusiastic support of league play and your cooperation in managing our court availability.

Announcing New Lesson Rates

TOCC announces revised lesson rates with our club Pros effective December 1, 2003:
